

JUNIOR ACTIVITIES POOL SWIM RECORDER

PURPOSE: The Junior Activities Pool Swim Recorder is primarily responsible to ensure that each child demonstrate a standard of competence to enable preliminary levels of survival skills in aquatic environment prior to the start of any junior activities

RESPONSIBLE TO: Junior Activities Training & Education Officer

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for keeping an accurate record of all junior activities pool swim times
- Responsible for pool swim attendance and organisation
- Liaise with the Registrar and/or Junior Activities Training & Education Officer once all pool swims have been completed

KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS REQUIRED:

- Works well with Children
- Good record keeping skills
- Communicate effectively and possess good interpersonal skills
- Friendly, positive and enthusiastic
- Knowledge of current SLSQ and Branch specific preliminary skills assessments; and water safety requirements or willing to promptly obtain

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a financial member of (insert club name) Surf Life Saving Club;
- Be the holder of a current "Blue Card" or "Exemption Notice" issued by the Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian
- Desirable to hold a proficient Bronze Medallion – Certificate II Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)
