RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for the training and assessment arrangements for the Junior Age Awards
- Work in conjunction with the Club's Chief Training Officer, Junior Activities Programs Coordinator, and Age Group Managers/ leaders
- In conjunction with the Chief Training Officer, actively train or recruit qualified members for JA water safety and Age Manager roles
- Organise specific educational programs and events to further the education of the JA membership
