Mudjimba SLSC Training courses 31/01/2023 to 31/07/2023

IRB Crew course Thursday 02/02/2023 to 18/02/2023 (full)

IRB Drivers course Date to be confirmed course early March. Qualifications required, hold a Marine License, hold an IRB Crew certificate and be 17 years of age at time of examination, expressions of interest to myself.

Bronze Medallion Course (prerequisites be minimum of 15 years of age), be able to complete a 400 m pool swim in under 9 mins. **Meeting Wednesday Night 22/02/2023. 6PM @** Mudjimba surf club for an hour to discuss dates and commitment. Course will run for about 6 weeks starting Saturday 25th of February. Please let me know prior.

Surf Rescue Certificate (water safety), prerequisites, be a minimum of 13 years of age upwards. Be able to complete a 200m pool swim in under 5 mins. **Meeting Wednesday Night 22/02/2023 6 pm,** Mudjimba surf club for an hour to discuss dates and commitment. Course will run for about 4 weeks starting Saturday 25th of February. Please let me know prior.

First aid course (HLTAID011), Wednesday night 8th of March and Thursday night 9th of March, 5:30 pm to 9:30 pm both nights. Prerequisites, be minimum of 14 years of age. Please let me know prior.

Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (HLTAID015) Wednesday night 5th of April 6 pm to 9pm and Thursday night 6th of April 6 pm to 9pm Mudjimba SLSC. Prerequisites need to be a minimum of 15 years of age and hold the First Aid Certificate (HLTAID011). Please let me know prior.

Silver Medallion Patrol Captain courses. Note these are Sunshine Coast Branch run courses and nomination need to be to me ASAP. Note you may not get the date you want depending on places. These courses may be run at other surf clubs or Sunshine Coast Branch. The course is run over 2 days, with an online component to be done prior. There are also some skills that need to be signed off by your current Patrol Captain, CTO or Club Captain. We are working to get these course days down to 1 day if possible. Prerequisites include be a minimum of 17 years of age and have 2 years patrol experience.
