Our SLSQ Core Purpose is: Zero Preventable Deaths in Queensland public waters.

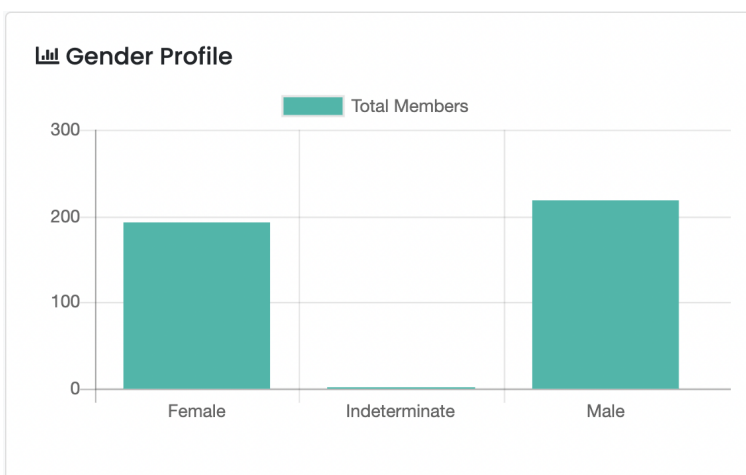
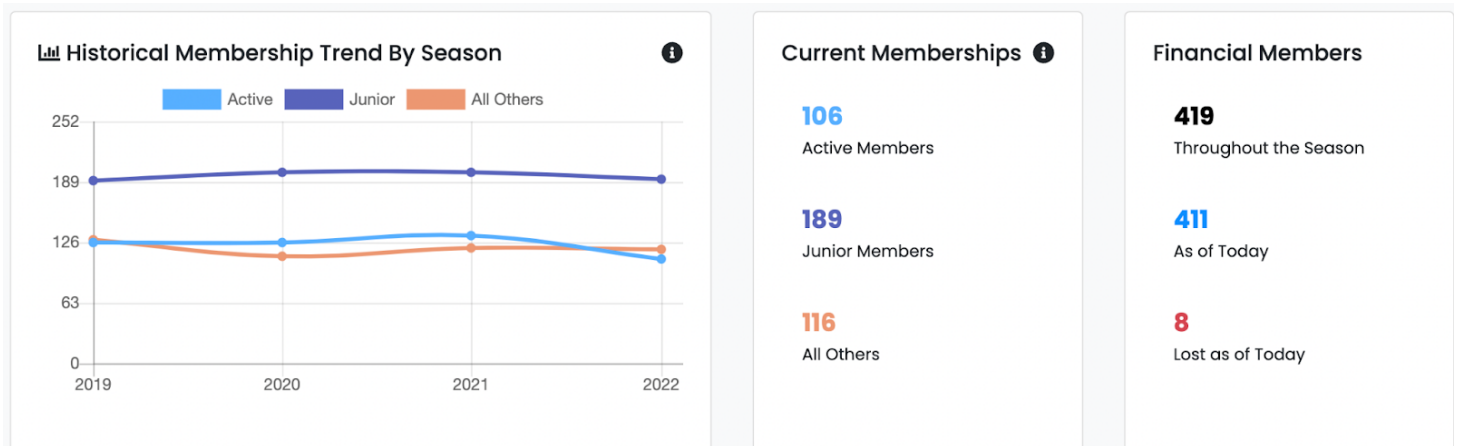
We value: Leadership, Community, Safety, Trust, Respect and Teamwork.
