## DIRECTOR OF JUNIOR ACTIVITIES - ZOE NAYLOR

We have 139 nippers signed up so far! The higher numbers are in the lower age groups and start to decrease as we get up to the Under 13s.

We have at least one age manager volunteer for most age groups. We still need an Under 11 Age Manager, and will need to confirm that some of the newer parents have completed their certifications, particularly CYRMS.

We have had many parents interested in water safety. Guy will be running an SRC course in October to help accommodate this interest – thanks Guy!

SLSQ released their Nipper Adult Assistant (NAA) criteria this week, so we will schedule a date for interested parents to sign up in early October. Parents just need to be a club member, have a blue card and complete CYRMS and SLSA Child Safe Awareness Courses online.

SLSQ has new nippers swim assessments guidelines, but that should not affect us for this year as we scheduled all pool swims prior to October 1. These will change the swim criteria for next year, but the new guidelines generally make it easier for the kids to show their proficiency.

We still need a lead volunteer to manage the barbecue for Nippers Sundays. I will be sending out weekly emails to remind the assigned age group parents to assist, but it would be helpful to have someone set up and shut down the barbecue each week as a central person to help oversee the barbecue – even if they do not want to actually cook.

Every Sunday we will need water safety volunteers. If you are SRC or Bronze, please come all Sundays from 8:00-10:30am
