### **Changes to Child Protection Legislation**

It is crucial that every member be fully aware of recent changes to the Child Protection Legislation in Queensland. Whilst SLSQ policies and procedures have provided a very solid base for us to protect child safety in our club and our community, recent changes to legislation have introduced a new level of accountability, namely the introduction of a new criminal offence under the Criminal Code of "Failure to Report sexual offences against children"

# Laws targeting sexual offences against children

The law has been strengthened to increase protection of children from the risk of sexual abuse.

#### As of 5 July 2021:

- all adults must report sexual offending against children to the police unless they have a reasonable excuse
- adults in an institutional setting (e.g. a school, church or sporting club) must protect children from the risk of
  a sexual offence being committed against them.

For these laws, child means a person under 16 or a person under 18 with an impairment of the mind.

An impairment of the mind, as defined in the Criminal Code, means a disability due to an intellectual, psychiatric, cognitive or neurological impairment (or a combination of these), which leaves the person with both:

- a substantial reduction in their capacity for communication, social interaction or learning
- a need for support.

These new laws are now in place and are applicable to all adults in Queensland. Please follow the link for detailed information if required. Mudjimba SLSC has complaints reporting and management processes in place and these are accessible on our Website. Please utilise our services or speak to our Grievance/Complaints Officer if you require further information or reach out for support from any member of the Executive or community-based support services.
